

Supplementary Table 1. Interview script.

Willingness/attitude

What were your feelings during the process, and did you remember the training you had received?

Do you consider it important to act as professionals or as citizens?

What is your opinion on the performance of law enforcement agencies in these matters?

Could the presence of family members or other witnesses affect your decisions?

Would you be willing to act again before the arrival of emergency services in the event of cardiorespiratory arrest?

CPR experience

How many times have you performed CPR during your job?

Are you aware of similar assistance by members of law enforcement agencies?

CPR training

What is the training you received during your professional career? When did you receive your last course?

Do you know what the current formal training is?

What is your opinion about the current training in your profession? Is it sufficient? Are more courses or periodic updates needed? What about the training of other professionals, such as police officers and firefighters?

CPR knowledge

What is the appropriate site for chest compressions in adults?

What is the frequency of chest compressions in the adult?

What is the depth of compressions in the adult?

What is the airway opening maneuver in an unconscious patient without cervical injury?

What is the airway opening maneuver in an unconscious patient with suspected cervical injury?

Which artery is indicated to determine the presence of a pulse in an adult patient in cardiorespiratory arrest?
